We are now planning our Chapter's 2016-2017 projects, one of which is hosting a NYS/UUP Joint Labor-Management Committees workshop titled "Managing Change with Style and Finesse." The workshop -- open to all WNY SUNY Chapters' members -- is already full. But never fear, we will be announcing several more workshops and social events for members!

On the state level, Statewide UUP's Negotiations Team continues formal bargaining with state negotiators into November. Though

our contract expired July 1, 2016: under the Triborough amendment to the Public Employees Fair Employment Act (Taylor Law), all contract articles continue until a successor agreement is ratified unless they contain specific expiration dates. Following negotiations, the Negotiations Team will present a tentative agreement to the UUP Negotiations Committee. The Committee then makes a recommendation to UUP membership regarding ratifications, and members of the Union then may vote on the tentative agreement. Over the years, the BBQ has grown exponentially, becoming Buff State UUP's annual, signature event. Now titled the Annual UUP Fall Kickoff BBQ, it serves as a model of an exemplary event for chapters throughout New York State to consider providing. Back to Fred Floss...besides being Buff State Economics and Finance Professor and past Buff State VP for Academics, Fred is also a past Statewide VP for Academics and past Statewide President -- which no doubt is how statewide chapters initially learned of the project as a way to greet faculty and staff for a new academic year, near the Labor Day holiday of significance to union members.

t's no accident that Buff State's UUP BBQ takes place near Labor Day. UUP Chapters throughout the state host and participate in events throughout the Labor Day period to show solidarity, how far unions have progressed with vital agendas, and highlight what remains to be done on behalf of members.

ertainly a lot has happened to grow Buff State UUP's annual barbecue be-→ tween the initial BBQ and now. Past President Steve Pendleton and current President Rick Stempniak further developed the event, putting their individual stamps on it. Tents, tables, and seating became necessary for dealing with all kinds of weather and for overall comfort. In 2013, the event was moved from outside the Classroom Building onto lawn in back of the Campbell Student Union. At the time, the college was tightening its financial belt, needing to maximize staff time so we all weren't continually taking down and setting up tents, tables, and chairs in different locations. Tents became permanently situated in back of the Student Union in clement months. At that time also made was the event name change from UUP BBQ to Annual UUP Fall Kickoff BBQ.

n 2016, a change of venue and vendor proved beneficial for the BBQ. Our Chapter Board agreed: the Social Hall now best fulfilled the event's purpose, and a change in catering by Chiavetta's was in order. We certainly received much positive feedback on BBQ day on September 9th this year that the changes were greatly appreciated by all. And sometimes we wonder just how much chicken and fixin's we've enjoyed over the years...hmm...any feedback?
