- Protect tenure and employment security.
- Enforce workplace safety.
- Ensure a sound pension plan.
- Provide exceptional dental and optical benefits.
- Negotiate important benefits, e.g., health, prescriptions, disability coverage.

- Arrange for special study leaves prior to tenure review.
