# Nina Mitchell, NYSUT Award Nominees

wo Buff State Chapter UUP Board members are nominated for two major awards: **Steve Pendleton** for the Nina Mitchell Award and **Jude Jayatilleke** for NYSUT Local Leadership.

Steve Pendleton (*pictured right*) personifies the Nina Mitchell Award bestowed annually to recognize one special colleague in New York State who serves, as Nina did, to make a chapter more effective on behalf of its members. Steve serves selflessly and effectively doing so in whatever capacity he is asked. Currently he is our Buff State Chapter UUP Grievance Officer for Academics.

Joining UUP when he arrived on campus in 1979, Steve became immediately active in UUP, traveling to Albany to fight for budget restorations and against retrenchments in 1980. When elected to Statewide UUP Delegate Assembly, he never missed a meeting in 30 years.

Steve was elected Buff State Chapter UUP President in 2001, a position he held for six years. He created ways to keep members





fully informed, was proactive in Labor-Management work, and devised systems to recruit new members and mobilize activists in times of crisis. Steve initiated tenure or continuing appointment workshops for academics and was proactive on the growing problems of professionals and adjuncts. He documented the compensation problem and convinced management to grant a major increase in base pay. Steve also served and serves on Statewide UUP Negotiations, Blue Ribbon DA, Economic Policy, and Solidarity committees. And yes, we have all benefited from Steve's sharp, analytical mind and gentle Southern wit, used to underline a point!

ur nominee for the NYSUT Local Leadership Award -- Jude Javatilleke (pictured left) -- recently was recognized by Statewide UUP for recruiting more new members for our Chapter than all 28 chapters combined did for theirs! Jude is Chapter Membership Liaison Specialist and Professional Staff Steward. He initiated our Membership Development Task Force and serves in Statewide Delegate Assembly and on EOP and Membership committees. A gracious man on a stellar career path, Jude holds Master's and Bachelor's from Buff State. He began work here as Admissions Communications Specialist and is now EOP Senior Academic Advisor. Jude is also instrumental in Staff Liaison and Professional Staff Caucus and active in the Western NY community at large.
